Notice is hereby given that the City of Mobile will receive sealed bids in the office of the City Clerk, Government Plaza, 205 Government Street, South Tower, 9<sup>th</sup> Floor, Mobile, Alabama, until 2:15 PM local time, on Wednesday, August 26, 2015, for the above stated project. The same will be publically opened and read at 2:30 PM local time in the AE Conference Room #558, Government Plaza, South Tower, 5<sup>th</sup> Floor. All bids received after the specified time will be automatically rejected and returned immediately, unopened. No bids may be withdrawn for a period of 60 days after the scheduled time for receipt. The City of Mobile reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities in this bidding. Bids must be submitted on copies of the Bid Form provided in the Bidding Documents.

A pre-bid conference will be held at the Architectural Engineering Department, 205 Government Street, South Tower, Fifth Floor, Room 558, Mobile, Alabama at 9:00 AM local time on Tuesday, August 18, 2015. A tour of the facilities will follow.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond or a cashier's check drawn on an Alabama bank payable to the City of Mobile in an amount not less than 5% of the base proposal amount, but in no event more than \$10,000. The successful qualified bidder shall also be required to provide a Performance Bond, Labor and Materials Payment Bond, Certificate of Insurance, and documentation of enrollment in the E-Verify program, prior to contract award.
