THE CONTRACT DOCUMENTS WILL BE AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:

Replace this language on page 4-5: “Bidders for work costing in excess of \$50,000 must be licensed Contractors in the State of Alabama pursuant to Sections 34-8-1 through 34-8-27 of the Code of Alabama of 1975 as amended. Bidders’ license must include the Specialty Construction (H/RR-S)–*Dredging*, as listed in the State of Alabama Licensing Board for General Contractors Administrative Code Chapter 230-X-1-.27 6.a.8. Bidders shall indicate State License Number on outside of bid envelope. All Bids of \$50,000 or more must be accompanied by a copy of the bidder’s Alabama General Contractor’s License,” with the following language:

“Bidders for work costing in excess of \$50,000 must be licensed Contractors in the State of Alabama pursuant to Sections 34-8-1 through 34-8-27 of the Code of Alabama of 1975 as amended. Bidders’ license must include one of the following: (MU) Municipal & Utility, (H/RR) Heavy / Railroad, or Specialty Construction (H/RR-S)–Dredging, as listed in the State of Alabama Licensing Board for General Contractors Administrative Code Chapter 230-X-1-.27 6.a.8. Bidders shall indicate State License Number on outside of bid envelope. All Bids of \$50,000 or more must be accompanied by a copy of the bidder’s Alabama General Contractor’s License.”

Replace this language on page 8: Bidders for work costing in excess of \$50,000 must be licensed Contractors in the State of Alabama pursuant to Sections 34-8-1 through 34-8-27 of the Code of Alabama of 1975 as amended. Bidders’ license must include the Specialty Construction (H/RR-S)–*Dredging*, as listed in the State of Alabama Licensing Board for General Contractors Administrative Code Chapter 230-X-1-.27 6.a.8”, with the following language:

“Bidders for work costing in excess of \$50,000 must be licensed Contractors in the State of Alabama pursuant to Sections 34-8-1 through 34-8-27 of the Code of Alabama of 1975 as amended. Bidders’ license must include one of the following: (MU) Municipal & Utility, (H/RR) Heavy / Railroad, or Specialty Construction (H/RR-S)–Dredging, as listed in the State of Alabama Licensing Board for General Contractors Administrative Code Chapter 230-X-1-.27 6.a.8.”

Replace this language on page 50 Section 2a: “Proof of licensing as Contractors in the State of Alabama pursuant to Sections 34-8-1 through 34-8-27 of the Code of Alabama of 1975 as amended. Bidders’ license must include the Specialty Construction (H/RR-S)–*Dredging*, as listed in the State of Alabama Licensing Board for General Contractors Administrative Code Chapter 230-X-1-.27 6.a.8,” with the following language:

“Proof of licensing as Contractors in the State of Alabama pursuant to Sections 34-8-1 through 34-8-27 of the Code of Alabama of 1975 as amended. Bidders’ license must include one of the following: (MU) Municipal & Utility, (H/RR) Heavy / Railroad, or Specialty Construction (H/RR-S)–Dredging, as listed in the State of Alabama Licensing Board for General Contractors Administrative Code Chapter 230-X-1-.27 6.a.8.”

Replace this language on page 51 Section 3b: “Copy of Alabama General Contractors License Number and proof of major classification Specialty Construction (H/RR-S) –*Dredging*” with the following language:

“Copy of Alabama General Contractors License Number and proof of major classification (one of the following): (MU) Municipal & Utility, (H/RR) Heavy / Railroad, or Specialty Construction (H/RR-S) –Dredging.”

SUBMITTED PRE-QUAL INFORMATIONAL MEETING QUESTIONS



PROJECT: Langan Lake Dredging (2016-3005-34) and
Langan Park Stormwater Improvements (2021-2045-01)

1. QUESTION: *In reference to the qualification of bidders section (pg. 51 sec. 2l), Do demonstrated projects of \$3 Million or greater have to include the use of geotubes?*

No. This requirement can include projects with any method of dredging.

2. QUESTION: *In reference to demonstrating a positive safety record for a minimum of 3 years, which safety records should be included in the Statement of Qualifications?*

Information can come from a variety of sources including OSHA logs, OSHA recordable rates, EMR, etc. as long as it demonstrates a positive safety record.

3. QUESTION: *Regarding proof of licensing as contractors in the State of Alabama, if the license does not currently include Specialty Construction (H/RR-S) Dredging, may we still qualify to bid with the intent of adding that credential prior to execution?*

Please send amended contract details on page 2. You will be required to have one of the following licenses prior to bidding:

- (MU) Municipal and Utility
- (H/RR) Heavy Railroad
- (H/RR-S) Dredging

4. QUESTION: *Would it be possible to extend the deadline of when the prime contractor must be approved for a Specialty Construction (H/RR-S) Dredging classification to when the project is going to get awarded instead of the bid opening date? If that timeline cannot be moved, would it be possible to have a dredging subcontractor hold the (H/RRS)- Dredging classification while the Prime Contractor has a Heavy MU license?*

The Prime contractor must have one of the three listed classifications to bid. Subcontractors must be licensed in the State of Alabama to begin work. All contractors and sub-contractors must also have a SAM.gov registration and UEI. The deadline will not be extended.
