CITY OF MOBILE SPECIFICATIONS FOR ROADWAY LIGHT POLE & LUMINAIRE Downtown Standards April 2023

General.

The following are the requirements for ductile iron roadway light pole and luminaire to meet the standards established within Downtown Mobile. The light pole shall consist of a one-piece fluted, tapered pole, anchor bolts, base plate, and any other features as described in this specification. The luminaire shall be an acorn style fixture complete with ring, struts and finial.

II. Light pole.

The pole shall consist of an 8-fluted (alternating curved and flat) tapered shaft manufactured in one piece cast ductile iron per A536-84 Grade 65-45-12. The octagonal pole shall be 11-feet in height with a nominal 20-inch outside bottom diameter at the base (flat to flat). Shaft shall range from approximately 20-inch at the bottom of the shaft to 205-inch at top of shaft with a flared finish width of 5-3/4-inch. The tenon shall be 3-1/2-inch diameter and 3-1/2-inch tall. The pole shall include an access door and tamper proof hex socket security machine screws for fastening to the pole.

The pole shall be primed and finished black.

Each pole will have grounding provisions inside the pole base opposite the access door to accommodate a 1/4-inch ground stud (stud not included).


The aluminum base plate of the pole shall be designed to accommodate a 12-inch bolt circle pattern. Pole shall come complete with four 3/4-inch x 24-inch L-type anchor bolts with 3" horizontal bend manufactured of hot-dipped galvanized steel. The anchor bolt assembly shall also include one nut and one washer per bolt. A 3" bolt projection is required.

The pole shall include a GFCI receptacle with in-use weather-proof cover centered 12-inches from top of pole. The cover shall be aluminum and finished textured black to match the pole. Orientation shall be forty-five degrees from access door.

III. Luminaire.

The luminaire shall be a decorative acorn consisting of a textured polycarbonate lens, ring and strut housing and vented finial. The luminaire shall be a 100 W LED fixture, designed for 120-277 voltage and a Type III light distribution. The overall fixture height shall measure 41-11/16-inch. The cast aluminum collar shall be 8-3/8-inch tall and size to accept a 3-1/2 inch diameter by 3-1/2-inch tall pole tenon. The finish shall be textured gloss black.




