

## City of Mobile Request for Proposals Addendum 1 to RFP 5872

## Medical Screening Services Mobile, Alabama Fire Rescue Department

The City of Mobile ("City") is seeking sealed proposals for the provision of health, wellness, and fitness assessments for Mobile Fire Rescue Department firefighters. The City is providing this Addendum 1 to respond to questions received regarding the original RFP.

The due date for written proposals remains 5:00 pm, April 9, 2024.

The full contents of the original Request for Proposals (RFP), and any subsequent Addenda to this RFP may be found on the City Bid page at https://www.cityofmobile.org/bids.

A. **QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**: The following question was received and the City determined that an answer to all potential proposers was merited. Where proposers remain unclear or uncertain of the City's requirements, proposers are to use judgment as to the City's intent, and state any questions or assumptions made in interpreting the City's RFP. All timely submitted RFPs will be fully considered and scored by the City.

1. The Pricing Sheet in Exhibit A requests itemized pricing for the listed services. We offer a standard package that includes most of the items listed, then offer the remaining services as options. Is it permissible to list "Included" or "Package" in the Pricing column for those services, or is an itemized price required for each line item?

Answer: Yes, it is permissible to propose "package pricing." Edit the sheet as necessary to indicate clearly what's included in the package and what the package price would be. Be sure that every item is accounted for in pricing, either in a package or individually. The "Additional tests that must be offered" at the end of the pricing sheet should include either an individual price for each, or, if in a package, an individual credit amount that would be offered if the City deselected that test from the package.
