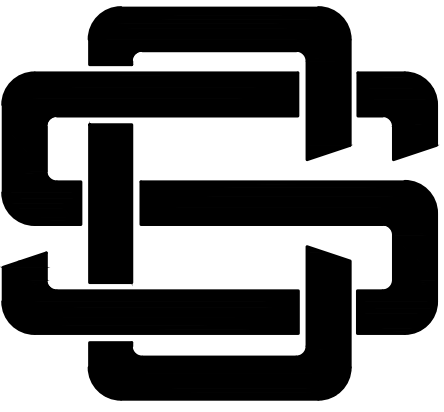
HANDICAP MARKING DETAIL

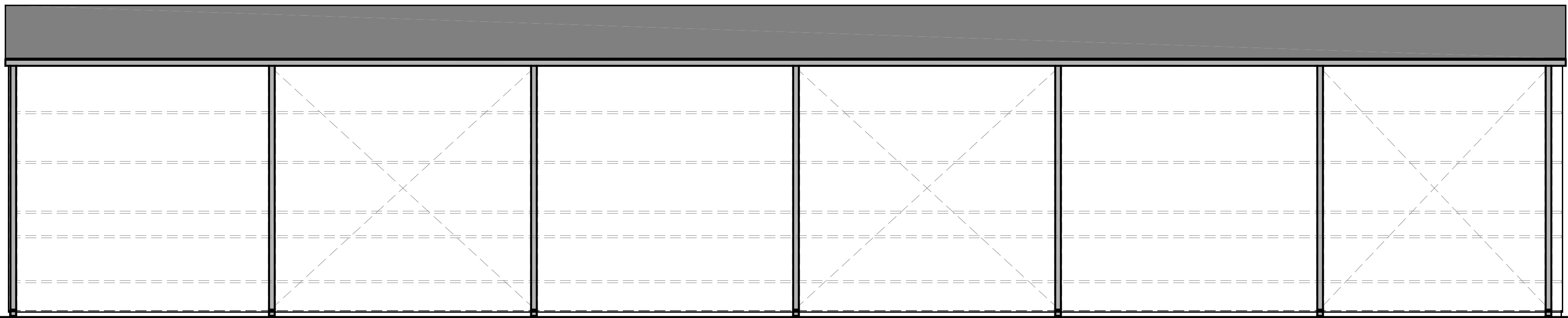

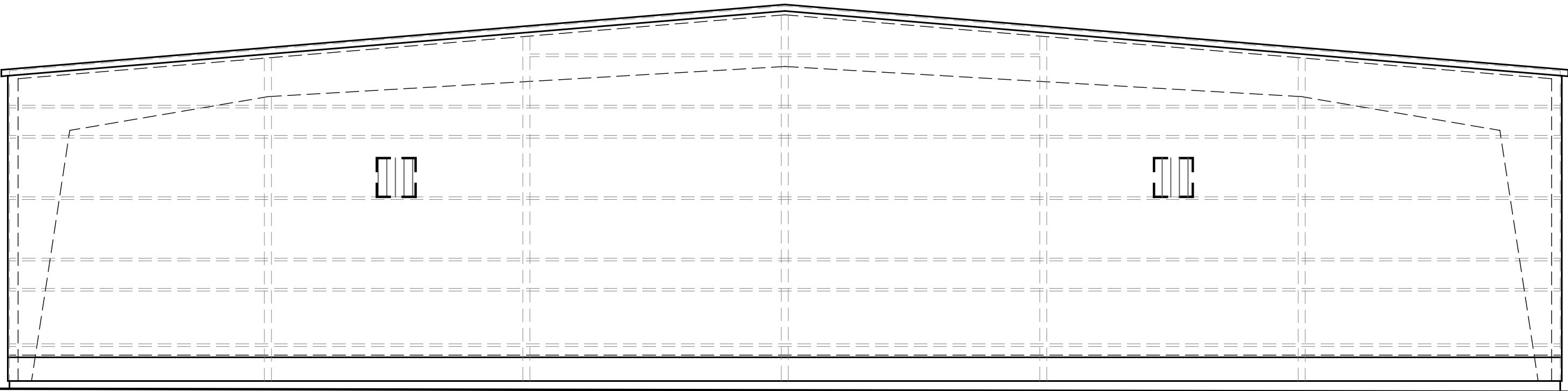

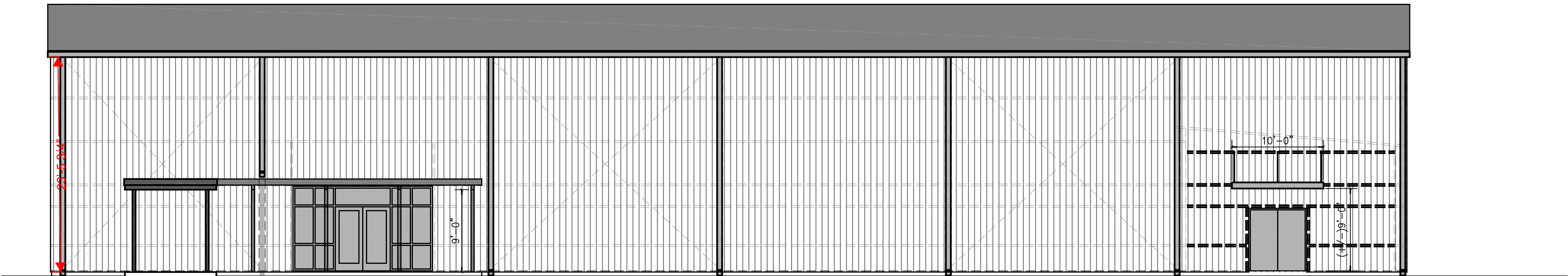

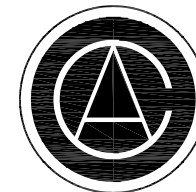


NORTH ELEVATION – NEW WORK

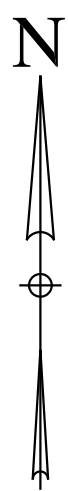
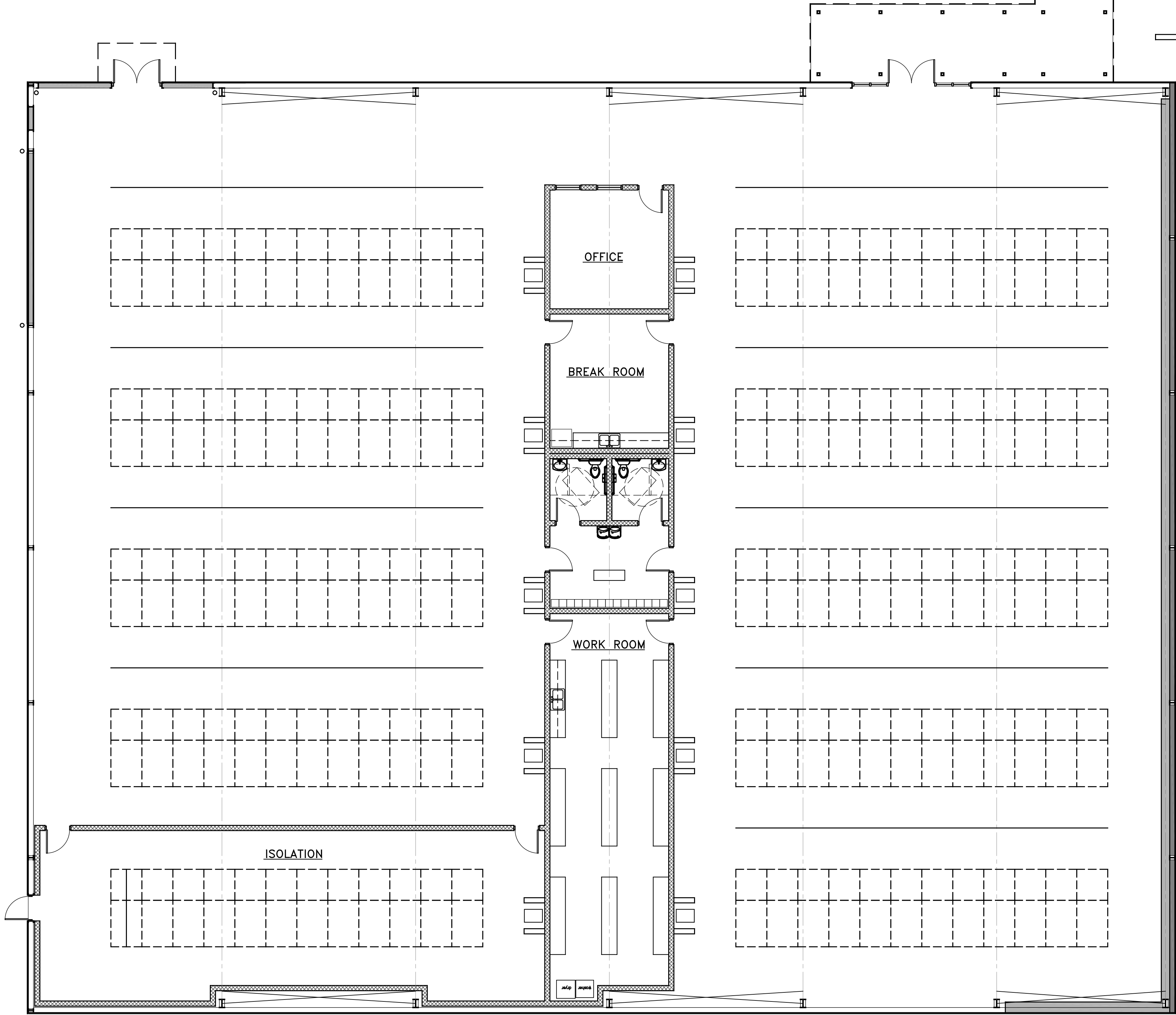
