This addendum forms a part of the Contract Documents and modifies the original Bidding Documents as noted below. Acknowledge receipt of this Addendum in the space provided on the Bid Form. Failure to do so may subject the Bidder to disqualifications.

PART 1 - GENERAL CHANGES

- 1.01 When a change is shown on a drawing, in a specification section or in a Document, keep that change consistent through all drawings, specifications and documents.
- 1.02 Reference attached "Pre-Bid Conference Agenda" dated October 5, 2022.
 - A. Add the following notes to the "Pre-Bid Conference Agenda":
 - "1. The project contains an ex. irrigation system. The Contractor will be allowed to remove and/or interrupt any part of the system which conflicts with construction activities. The Contractor shall mark all water and electrical cuts in the Ex. system with flagging and notify the City of Mobile, Landscape Services, Allen Reed @ 251.208-1600 or 251.508-2767 (cell) within 24 hours of interrupting the existing service.
 - 2. Contractor shall be responsible for repairing/adjusting or modifying the ex. irrigation system to accommodate new construction and continue to provide a fully operational automatic irrigation system. Contractor to submit shop drawings of proposed irrigation plan for approval by Architect prior to installation."

- 1.04 Responses to Questions:
 - Scale on EC100, LD100, LS100 shows 1' equals 20'. Is this correct? Response: The scale on EC100, LD100, LS100 should be <u>1-inch = 20 feet</u>.
 - AS-101, is there a modification to the Dog Park? *Response: There are NO modifications to the Dog Park.*"
 - A400 Toilet Paper Dispenser. It states this will be supplied by Owner. Is this correct? *Response: Yes. The toilet paper dispensers are supplied by the Owner and installed and painted by the Contractor.*

3. Discussion of Scope of Work.

a. Discuss scope.

Langan Park Base Bid: The project consists a new restroom building, parking, improvements to an existing pavilion and improvements to an existing restroom.

Public Safety Memorial Park Base Bid: The project consists of a new restroom building, improvements to an existing skateboard park and improvements to an existing pavilion and converting a wading pool to a splashpad.

All construction sites for City of Mobile projects shall be undertaken in accordance with the Clean Water Act; the Alabama Water Pollution Control act; the current version of the Alabama Handbook for Erosion Control, Sediment Control and Stormwater Management on Construction Sites and Urban Areas; and the current version of the Mobile, Alabama City Code Chapter 17 Stormwater Management and Flood Control.

b. Protect all existing non-moveable items through the course of construction. Verify with Project Manager if non-moveable item conflicts with work areas.

4. Special Instructions or conditions.

- a. Contractors are to confirm with the Alabama Licensing Board for General Contractors that they hold the required Contractor's License to Bid this project. Contractors found to have illegally bid this project may be subjected to fines by the Alabama Licensing Board for General Contractors and possible rejection of Bid.
- b. Contractor shall provide sanitary facilities on site at an approved location if none are available.
- c. Contractor may utilize, without cost, the water and electricity, if it's available at the site.
- d. City of Mobile permits are required for the construction, but are available without cost to the Contractor. General Contractor shall have a current \$10,000 Surety Bond on file with the City of Mobile Permitting Division prior to issuance of permits and throughout the contract duration.

- e. Remove waste and surplus materials, rubbish, and construction facilities from the site. Contractor may provide a dumpster and shall coordinate placement with the Project Manager.
- f. Contractor shall coordinate schedule for work and access to the project site with the Project Manager. Contractor is cautioned that the park will remain in use. Maintain a safe and secure job site. A construction fence shall always be maintained around the perimeter of the Work area.
- g. Any observed discrepancies, omissions or errors in any part of the contract documents shall be submitted as written RFIs to Daniel Borcicky at <u>dborcicky@tagarchitects.net</u>.
- h. Cut off time for submission of RFIs is 3:00 PM, at least Ten (10) calendar days prior to the Bid Opening.
- i. Submissions for substitutions shall be submitted no later than Ten (10) calendar days prior to Bid opening. All submitted information shall include detailed comparisons of all characteristics of the Basis of Design product.
- j. Official clarifications, corrections or acceptance of substitutions will be made by written addendum sent to all registered prospective bidders via e-mail.
- k. Work hours are acceptable as correspond to the site hours, generally dusk to dawn, seven days a week, unless other time(s)/day(s) are coordinated with the Owner and agreed upon in advance.

5. Bidding instructions, forms, special requirements and time.

- a. Bid Date is Wednesday, November 2, 2022.
- b. Substantial Completion is two hundred seventy (270) calendar days from Notice to Proceed.
- c. There are no Alternates at this time.
- d. Bid Form with Bid Security, in the form of a Bid Bond or Bid Check is required.
- e. Use of \$25,000.00 Contingency Allowance at each park and use of \$25,000.00 site work allowance at Langan Park shall be reviewed and approved by the Owner. Any remaining contingency will be returned to the City of Mobile via Change Order.
- f. This is a tax exempt project.
- g. Contractor shall provide an appropriately completed copy of the "City of Mobile Subcontracting and Major Supplier Plan" in the envelope with their Bid Form. Form shall document DBE Subcontractors participating in the project and, should the total % of DBE participation not meet the 15% minimum, all efforts to obtain DBE Subcontractors shall be documented on or attached to the DBE Form when submitted.
- h. Liquidated Damages shall be assessed at a rate of \$250 per calendar day. See project manual for detailed informaton. Contractor may submitt appropriately documented "rain days", for consideration to add days to the contract. Delays in materials will not be a reason to postpone work unless Contractor submits written documentation, to be approved, that critical path has been affected.

6. Additional Requirements at time of Contract execution:

- a. A valid City of Mobile business license for the duration of the contract period
- b. E-verify Documentation: The Beason-Hammond Taxpayer Protection Act applies to this project. Contractor shall comply with the requirements of

this Act and show proof of enrollment in the E-verify program by submitting the electronically generated Federal E-verify document prior to signing of the construction contract. (see Project Manual)

- c. A Performance Bond and Labor & Material Payment Bond is required. (see Project Manual)
- d. Certificate of Insurance in amounts and with endorsements as required by the City of Mobile. (see Project Manual)
- e. Current W-9 form and City of Mobile Vendor Information Form, if same has not been submitted within the last four months. (see Project Manual)
- f. DBE Utilization Report. (see Project Manual)
- g. All of the above MUST be correctly completed and returned to the Project Manager within ten (10) calendar days of Contractor receiving the contract agreement.
- h. Contractor will be required to submit all Pay Applications, Submittals to be reviewed, and email correspondence through E-Builder Project Management Software (at no cost to the Contractor).

7. Payment requirements.

- a. Retainage withheld at 5% of the first 50% of Construction Completed until the amount equals 2.5% of the full contract amount.
- b. The final 2.5% of the full contract amount is withheld as retainage until all close out requirements are met, proof of advertisement, warranties, Consent of Surety and release of liens, etc. By State of Alabama Law, notice of final completion of the contract shall be published in a local newspaper of general circulation.

SUPPLEMENTARY INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

THE ATTENTION OF ALL BIDDERS IS CALLED TO THE FOLLOWING INSTRUCTIONS AND CONDITIONS:

I. BIDDING DOCUMENTS:

A. Bidders may obtain complete sets of Bid Documents and Specifications (Project Manual) from the Department of Architectural Engineering as listed in the Invitation to Bid.

B. Bidders shall use the complete set of documents in preparing their bid. The City of Mobile assumes no responsibility for errors or misinterpretations resulting from use of an incomplete set of documents.

Bidders shall use the complete set of documents in preparing their bid. Neither the City of Mobile nor the Engineer (Architect) assume responsibility for errors or misinterpretations resulting from use of an incomplete set of documents.

2. INTERPRETATION OF BID DOCUMENTS:

- A. Bidders shall carefully study and compare the Bidding Documents and compare various components of the Bidding Documents with each other, encouraged to examine the site and local conditions and shall at once report to the Project Manager any errors, inconsistencies or ambiguities discovered.
- B. Bidders requiring clarification or interpretation of the Bidding Documents shall make a written request to the Project Manager by 3:00 PM at least ten (10) calendar days prior to the date for receipt of Bids. E-mail requests are required and should be addressed to <u>dborcicky@tagarchitects.net</u>. Interpretations, corrections and changes to the Bidding Documents will be made by a formal, written Addendum. Interpretations, corrections and changes to the Bidding Documents will not be binding, and Bidders shall not rely on them.
- C. Any discrepancy not resolved prior to Bidding shall be bid by the Contractor to provide for the most costly and/or restrictive interpretation of the documents.

3. BIDDING PROCEDURES:

- A. No Bid will be considered unless made out and submitted on a copy of the Bid Form as set forth by the Bid Documents.
- B. All blanks on the Bid Form shall be legibly executed in a non-erasable medium.
- C. Sums shall be expressed in both words and figures. In case of discrepancy, the amount written in words shall govern.
- D. Interlineations, alterations and erasures must be initialed by the signer of the Bid.

- E. All requested Alternates, Unit Prices and Allowances shall be bid as indicated on the Bid Form and the Bid Documents.
- F. Addenda shall be considered as a part of the Bid Documents and those issued prior to the opening of Bids shall be acknowledged on the Bid Form and any adjustment in cost shall be included in the Contract Sum.
- 4. BID SECURITY:
 - A. A Cashier's Check drawn on a bank registered to do business in the State of Alabama and which is a member of the Federal Deposit Insurance Corporation, or Bid Bond payable to Owner, City of Mobile, in the amount of 5% of the Base Bid, but in no event more than \$10,000.00, must accompany bid. By submitting a Bid Security, the Bidder pledges to enter into a Contract with the City of Mobile on the terms stated in the Bid, and will, if required, furnish bonds covering faithful performance of the Contract and required insurance certificate. Should the Bidder refuse to enter into such Contract or fail to furnish such bonds or insurance or any other required document, the amount of the Bid security shall be forfeited to the Owner as liquidated damages, not as a penalty.
 - B. Bid Bond shall be valid for a minimum of sixty (60) days from the date of the Bid. The Owner reserves the right to retain the security of all Bidders until the successful Bidder enters into the Contract or until (60) days after Bid opening, whichever is sooner.
 - C. Bonds must be issued by a Surety licensed to do business in the State of Alabama. If the project cost is more than \$50,000.00 the Surety must have a minimum rating of A/Class VI as reported by the latest issue of Best's Key Rating Guide Property-Casualty published by Alfred M. Best Company, Inc.
 - D. Power of Attorney is required for all Bonds.
 - E. The Surety company shall be required to execute AIA Document G-707, "Consent of Surety to Final Payment" prior to Final Payment of retainage being made to the Contractor.
- 5. EXAMINATION OF DOCUMENTS AND SITE WORK:
 - A. Before submitting a Bid, Bidders should carefully examine the Bid Documents, visit the site of the Work, including attendance at the Pre-Bid conference, fully inform themselves as to existing conditions and limitations, and include in the Bid a sum to cover the cost of all items included in the Contract and necessary to perform the Work. The submission of a Bid will be considered as conclusive evidence that the Bidder has made such examination.
- 6. SUBMISSION OF BIDS:
 - A. Bid, with Bid Security, Sales Tax Form C-3A, City of Mobile Subcontracting & Major Supplier Plan and other supporting data specified, shall be contained in a sealed, opaque envelope, approximately 9 x 12 inches or larger and be marked on the outside

with the words **SEALED BID FOR LANGAN PARK – PAVILION AMPHITHEATER & RESTROOM - PROJECT NUMBER: PR-031-21 AND PUBLIC SAFETY MEMORIAL PARK RESTROOM, SKATEBOARD PARK & SPLASHPAD – PROJECT NUMBER PR-093-21**", the Bid Date, and Contractor's name, address, and City of Mobile Business License number. And, if bidding in an amount \$50,000 or greater, the State of Alabama General Contractor's License number and classification of the Bidder issued by the State of Alabama Licensing Board for General Contractors shall be written on the envelope.

- B. Bids shall be deposited at the designated location prior to the time and date for receipt of Bids. Bids received after the time and date specified in the Invitation to Bid, or as modified by Addendum, will not be considered. Late Bids will be returned to the Bidder unopened.
- C. The Bidder shall assume full responsibility for timely delivery at the location designated for receipt of Bids.
- D. Oral, telephonic, facsimile or other electronically transmitted bids will not be considered.
- 7. MODIFICATION OR WITHDRAWAL OF BIDS:
 - A. A Bid may not be modified, withdrawn, or canceled by the Bidder for a period of sixty (60) days following the time and date designated for receipt of bids, and each Bidder so agrees in submitting a Bid.
- 8. CONSIDERATION AND AWARD OF BIDS:
 - A. At the discretion of the City, the properly identified Bids received on time will be publicly opened and will be read aloud.
 - B. The City shall have the right to reject any and all Bids. A Bid not accompanied by a required Bid security or a Bid which is in any way incomplete or irregular is subject to rejection.
 - C. It is the intent of the City to award a Contract to the lowest qualified Bidder provided the Bid has been submitted in accordance with the requirements of the Bidding Documents and does not exceed the funds available. The City shall have the right to waive informalities and irregularities in a Bid received and to accept the Bid which, in the City's judgment, is in the City's best interest.
 - D. The award shall be based on the lowest Total Bid for the Base Bid and any allowances, plus any alternates and/or options that may be accepted, as listed on the Bid Form.
- 9. PROOF OF COMPETENCY OF BIDDER:
 - A. Bidders may be required to furnish evidence satisfactory to the City of Mobile that they have sufficient means and experience in the types of work called for to assure the completion of the Contract in a satisfactory manner.
- 10. SIGNING OF CONTRACT:

- A. The Standard Agreement between the City of Mobile and the Contractor, included herein, shall serve as the Agreement between the City and the Contractor.
- B. The Bidder to whom the Contract is awarded shall, within ten (10) calendar days of receiving the Contract Forms, properly execute and deliver to the Owner, the following items with the signed Agreement:
 - (1). Performance Bond and Labor and Material Payment Bond (originals);
 - (2). Certificate of Insurance (original) with endorsements to City of Mobile;
 - (3). Evidence of enrollment in the E-Verify program.
 - (4). Other documentation as required by the Contract Documents.
- C. Failure or refusal to sign the Agreement or to provide Certificates of Insurance in a form satisfactory to the City of Mobile, E-Verify verification, or other required documentation, shall subject the Bidder to immediate forfeiture of Bid Security.
- D. On all documents: City of Mobile Business License, the Alabama Secretary of State Business Identity, the Alabama Secretary of State Certificate of Authority (out of state contractors), E-verify documentation, and ACORD Insurance Form, the Contractor's name shall be EXACTLY the same.

11. NONDISCRIMINATION:

- A. Contractor shall comply with all Federal, State and local laws concerning nondiscrimination, including but not limited to City of Mobile Ordinance No. 14-034 which requires, inter alia, that all contractors performing work for the City of Mobile not discriminate on the basis of race, creed, color, national origin or disability, require that all subcontractors they engage do the same, and make every reasonable effort to assure that fifteen percent of the work performed under contract be awarded to socially and economically disadvantaged individuals and business entities.
- 12. AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA):
 - A. Bidders shall comply with the provisions of the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) of 1990 which prohibits discrimination against individuals with disabilities.

13. USE OF DOMESTIC PRODUCTS:

A. Section 39-3-1, Alabama Code, 1975, provides that the Contractor agree, in the execution of this Contract, to use materials, supplies and products manufactured, mined, processed or otherwise produced in the United States or its territories, if available at reasonable prices, and that breach of this Agreement by the Contractor shall result in the assessment of liquidated damages in an amount not less than \$500.00 nor more than twenty (20) percent of gross amount of the Contract Price.

14. NON-RESIDENT (OUT OF STATE) CONTRACTORS:

A. Preference to Resident Contractors: Section 39-3-5, Code of Alabama, 1975, provides that a non-resident (out of State) bidder domiciled in a state which grants a preference to local Contractors is to be awarded a public contract on the same basis as the non-resident bidder's state awards contracts to Alabama bidders. Alabama bidders are

given a preference to the same extent that a non-resident bidder receives a preference in his home state. A non-resident bidder must include with any written bid documents a written opinion of an attorney licensed to practice in the non-resident bidder's state declaring what preferences, if any, exists in the non-resident's state.

- B. Certificate of Authority: All non-resident (out of State) bidders shall be registered with the Alabama Secretary of State and the Alabama Department of Revenue prior to submitting a Bid. Provide the Secretary of State Business "Entity ID Number" on the Bid Form in the space provided.
- 15. ALABAMA IMMIGRATION ACT:
 - A. The State of Alabama Immigration Law (Act No. 2011-535 as amended by Act No. 2012-491), requires that Contractors not violate federal immigration law or knowingly employ, hire for employment, or continue to employ an unauthorized alien within the State of Alabama. In addition, Contractors are required to enroll in the federal E-Verify program and submit verification of enrollment to the City of Mobile within ten (10) days of receiving the contract forms (see Section 00600).
- 16. CITY OF MOBILE BUSINESS LICENSE:
 - A. A City of Mobile Business License is required and must be current at time of contract award and throughout contract period.
- 17. CITY OF MOBILE CONTRACTOR'S BUSINESS LICENSE:
 - A. A City of Mobile Contractor's Business License is required and must be current when contractor signs the contract and throughout contract period.
 - B. Contractor must qualify and post a \$10,000 surety bond with the Land Use/Code Administration Department before a Contractor's Business License will be issued by the Revenue Department. Information on the City Contractor's License may be obtained by writing or calling:





1. The contractor shall notify the City of Mobile ROW Section via e-mail at rightofway.inspect@cityofmobile.org a minimum of 24 hours prior to beginning any work within the ROW or Public Easement for assignment of the City of Mobile ROW inspector. Prior notice applies to all activity within the ROW including mobilization, trenching, boring, concrete placement, etc. Failure to contact the City of Mobile ROW Section prior to beginning any work is a violation of the City of Mobile ROW Ordinance and may invoke enforcement action in the form of a Municipal Offense Ticket.

2. The ROW Permit shall expire upon the completion of the work or if there is any suspension in the progression of work greater than or equal to six (6) months from the date of permit approval. The City may require a submission of a schedule/deadline for completion of work. Permitted work in the ROW not completed in a timely manner is a violation of the City of Mobile ROW Ordinance and may invoke enforcement action in the form of a Municipal Offense Ticket.

3. The contractor shall schedule and obtain an approved formwork inspection from the assigned City of Mobile ROW inspector prior to placement of concrete to confirm minimum dimensional standards are met. 4. The permittee shall schedule and obtain an approved pipe inspection from the City of Mobile ROW inspector prior to placement of UTII ITY PLAN NOTES fill to confirm pipe joints are wrapped and no lifting holes are present.

5. The contractor shall immediately notify the City of Mobile ROW section via e-mail at

rightofway.inspect@cityofmobile.org of any incidental damage to any City of Mobile facilities in the ROW or Public Easements including sidewalks, driveways, ADA ramps, curb and gutter, drainage structures and pipes, etc. The contractor shall be responsible for the repair of any damaged facilities to the City of Mobile standards, in a timely manner, and at no cost to the City of Mobile. 6. All work within the City of Mobile ROW or Public Easements must comply with the "Mobile Rights of Way Construction and Administration Ordinance". A copy of the ordinance may be found at the Municode website for the City of Mobile Ordinance Chapter 57, Article VIII.

7. All work in the ROW shall comply with the Stormwater Management and Flood Control Ordinance and Flood Plain Management Plan of the City of Mobile, Alabama, including but not limited to:

a. Do not alter the natural drainage flow pattern in the area of work.

b. Do not divert storm water onto adjacent property or increase the amount of natural drainage flow onto an adjacent property owner or prevent the natural flow of water in the area of work.

c. Do not fill wetlands without a permit from the US Army Corps of Engineers. d. Do not fill within or alter a Special Flood Hazard Area (floodplain) without an engineered flood study or violate any of the requirements in Division 2 of the Stormwater Management and Flood Control Ordinance specifically.

8. With the exception of major roadway rehabilitations/improvements, all restoration work associated with excavations within a public roadway including the placement and compaction of sub-base, base, and bituminous or concrete pavement shall comply with City of Mobile Standard Drawings 11 (Sheets 1-3) (whichever is applicable). Refer to the standard drawing details included in this plan set. 5. 9. The final resurfacing limits of any roadway restoration shall be at the discretion of the City Engineer, to be determined by a field inspection/site visit upon completion of the installation of all permitted infrastructure/facilities, prior to the contractor beginning paving.

10. All sidewalk construction in the ROW shall comply with City of Mobile Standard Drawing 12. Refer to the standard drawing details included in this plan set.

11. Sidewalks in the ROW shall not be obstructed, parked upon, or driven upon without explicit approval documented in writing or on the permitted plans. Failure to comply with this requirement may invoke enforcement action in the form of a Municipal Offense Ticket.

12. On substantial development/redevelopment projects, any sidewalk panels in the ROW which are cracked, have been shoved creating a tripping hazard, or those which have been worn to the extent that they create a slipping hazard, shall be replaced. The determination of this condition is ultimately the decision of the City.

13. All driveway apron construction in the ROW shall comply with City of Mobile Standard Drawings 3 (Sheets 1 and 2), 5/5 SW (Sheets 1 and 2), 6, or 10 (whichever is applicable). Refer to the standard drawing details included in this plan set. 14. All ADA ramps and landing construction in the ROW shall comply with City of Mobile Standard Drawings 7 (Sheets 1 and 2), 8 (Sheets 1 and 2), 9 (Sheets 1 and 2) (whichever is applicable). Refer to the standard drawing details included in this plan set. ADA

compliant truncated dome panels shall be anchored and cast in place, not bolted down and retrofitted.

15. All control and expansion jointing in the ROW shall comply with the material and dimensional requirements on City of Mobile Standard Drawing 12. Wood shall not be used as expansion joint material. Expansion joints shall be required where any concrete structure abuts another concrete structure or non-yielding material. The spacing of control and expansion joints for various concrete 8 structures shall be as follows: a. Sidewalks - Control joins shall be placed every 4 feet or equivalent with the width of the sidewalk (maximum 10 feet). Expansion joints shall be placed every 30 feet to 32 feet. b. Driveways and Curb and Gutter - Control joints shall be placed every 8 feet to 10 feet. Expansion joints shall be placed every 32 feet to 40 feet.

16. All storm drain pipe installed in the City of Mobile ROW, Public Easement, or carrying City of Mobile system stormwater shall have the joints wrapped with filter fabric, shall have no lifting holes (filling lifting holes is not allowed without explicit approval), shall be a minimum of 15 inch in diameter, and shall be Class III or stronger reinforced concrete pipe (RCP). The contractor needs to notify the pipe manufacturer ahead of time that the project is within the City of Mobile ROW to obtain pipe without lifting holes. 17. Storm drainage connections shall occur at the junction box or inlet. If there is not an existing inlet or junction box to connect to, then one shall be constructed in accordance with relevant ALDOT Standard and Special Drawings.

18. Any excess soil produced as a result from any excavation in the ROW shall be removed from the ROW. 19. No excavations in the ROW shall be left open overnight unless the excavation has been properly secured with appropriate safety equipment (e.g. steel plates, barricades, safety fencing/screening). Excavations in the ROW shall not be left open for excessive amounts of time regardless of safety equipment

20. No excavations or jetting shall be done under the curbs and gutters, sidewalk, or driveways, or other hardscapes within the ROW without removal and replacement of the overlying structure.
