This Addendum forms a part of, and modifies, the Request for Bids for the above referenced project, dated August 6, 2025. Acknowledge the receipt of this Addendum No. 2 and all subsequent Addenda, if any, in the space provided on the Bid Form. Failure to do so may subject Bidder to disqualification.

General:

Clarifications:

- Item 1. The items to be included in the Base Bid design and Additive Alternate #1 design have been changed per the RFI answers listed below.
- Item 2. The Bid forms should only list an amount for the revised Base Bid design, and the Additive Alternate #1 should be blank.
- Item 3. The selected preferred low bidder shall be provided with revised drawings that shall include all the Addendum items
- Item 4. Extended cut-off for questions (emailed to <u>elizabeth.miller@cityofmobile.org</u>) to Friday, 8/15/25 at 3:00pm.

RFI's:

- Question 1. The base bid is to change the existing R22 condensing units and evaporator coils and keep the existing AHU's but there are several problems with this. The current EPA regulations do not allow an existing R22 system to be upgraded to R410A. Furthermore, the EPA regulations do not allow evaporator coils using A2L refrigerants to be field installed in existing AHU's that were not originally designed for A2L. This also violates UL requirements. Leak detection is required to be factory designed and installed and that is impossible with a partial retrofit like this. I see no mention of leak detection in the base bid details. Would the City and their inspectors be willing to provide a code variance in writing prior to bid that also exempts the contractor and manufacturer from the applicable EPA and UL requirements? If not, then the other option would be to restructure the bid where the base bid also includes the replacement of the complete AHU's including the factory leak detection.
- Answer 1. After careful review of the latest EPA and UL regulations, it shall not be acceptable to retrofit the existing R-22 air handling units to operate with the latest A2L refrigerant. The code does allow for the existing units to be retrofit under the condition that the City of Mobile, Alabama Officials issue a variance. Issuing a variance is not recommended by Isaiah Engineering.
- Question 2 Sheet M-1.0 note 21 reads "THE EXISTING DDC (DIRECT DIGITAL CONTROL) SYSTEM SHALL REMAIN IN PLACE TO CONTROL THE NEW EQUIPMENT". Based on my site visits there is no functional DDC system. I attached a picture I took of one of these "DDC" panels. The existing AHU's have 2 stage thermostats on them with stages jumped together when they should be controlling the 4 stages of cooling. The new systems are 4 stage cooling systems and should also have modulating HW heating control. Furthermore, the leak detection system required for A2L refrigerants will require additional logic than what is currently installed with the old residential thermostats. I did not see any mention of leak detection devices mentioned in the plans or specs. A new DDC system will be required to control these systems well. If just thermostatic controls are desired, then new thermostats and wiring will be required to control it satisfactorily.
- Answer 2. After careful review of the existing HVAC control systems, a central DDC system does not exist. The existing control system shall be modified as required to provide a fully functional and complete HVAC system. The work shall include but shall not be limited to removing and replacing existing thermostats for both AHU-1 and AHU-2. The new air handling units shall include A2L leak detection and control.

Description of upcoming plan revisions due to RFIs #1 & 2:

- A. **Drawing Sheet M-1.0**: the following revisions to the General Notes shall be as follows:
 - a. General Note 13E shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following: "Removal and replacement of existing air handling unit AHU-1."

- b. General Note 13F shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following: "Removal and replacement of existing air handling unit AHU-2."
- c. The following Paragraph 13P shall be added to General Notes in its entirety: "Provide the labor and materials to remove and replace the existing the existing thermostat for AHU-1 (Activities Center) with a <u>new</u> thermostat. The new thermostat shall be capable of operating two (2) stages of heating and four (4) stages of cooling. The thermostat shall be model a Honeywell T7350D (or Engineer approved equal)."
- d. The following Paragraph 13Q shall be added to General Notes in its entirety:
- e. "Provide the labor and materials to remove and replace the existing the existing thermostat for AHU-2 (Gymnasium) with a new thermostat. The new thermostat shall be capable of operating two (2) stages of heating and four (4) stages of cooling. The thermostat shall be model a Honeywell T7350D (or Engineer approved equal)."
- f. General Note 14 shall be deleted in its entirety.
- B. **<u>Drawing Sheet M-2.0</u>**: The following revisions to the Key Notes shall be as follows:
 - a. Keynote No. 1 shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - b. "The Contractor shall provide the labor and materials to remove and replace the air handling units AHU-1 & AHU-2, condensing units CU-1A, CU-1B, CU-2A, CU-2B and Boiler HB-1"
 - c. Keynote No. 2 shall be deleted in its entirety.
- C. **Drawing Sheet M-3.0**: The following revisions to the Keynotes shall be as follows:
 - a. Keynote No. 1 shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following: "The Contractor shall provide the labor and materials to remove and replace the air handling units AHU-1 & AHU-2, condensing units CU-1A, CU-1B, CU-2A, CU-2B and Boiler HB-1 "
 - b. Keynote No. 2 shall be deleted in its entirety.
- D. <u>Drawing Sheet M-4.0</u>: Base Bid and Bid Alternate #1 items shall refer to Drawings M-1.0, M-2.0 and M-3.0.
- E. <u>Drawing Sheet E-1.0:</u> The following revisions to the Keynotes shall be as follows:
 - a. The following Item No. F shall be added to Keynote No. 5 in its entirety: "Removal and replacement of existing air handling unit AHU-1."
 - b. The following Item No. G shall be added to Keynote No. 5 in its entirety:
 - c. "Removal and replacement of existing air handling unit AHU-2."
 - d. Keynote No. 6 shall be deleted in its entirety.
- F. **Drawing Sheet E-2.0:** The following revisions to the Keynotes shall be as follows:
 - a. The following Item No. F shall be added to Keynote No. 4 in its entirety: "Removal and replacement of existing air handling unit AHU-1."
 - b. The following Item No. G shall be added to Keynote No. 4 in its entirety: "Removal and replacement of existing air handling unit AHU-2."
 - c. Keynote No. 5 shall be deleted in its entirety.
- G. **<u>Drawing Sheet E-3.0</u>**: The following revisions to the Keynotes shall be as follows:

- a. The following Item No. F shall be added to Keynote No. 4 in its entirety: "Removal and replacement of existing air handling unit AHU-1."
- b. The following Item No. G shall be added to Keynote No. 4 in its entirety: "Removal and replacement of existing air handling unit AHU-2."
- c. Keynote No. 5 shall be deleted in its entirety.
