This addendum forms a part of, and modifies, the Request for Quotes for the above referenced project, dated May 10, 2022. Acknowledge the receipt of the Addendum No. 1, and any subsequent Addenda, in the space provided on the Quote Form. Failure to do so may subject bid to disqualification.

General:

- Item 1. The Mandatory Pre-Quote Conference Agenda with Modifications and Pre-Bid Conference Attendance Roster, dated May 26, 2022, are attached and form part of Addendum No. 1.
- Item 2. Mr. Roger Cook with the City of Mobile's Supplier Diversity Office was present and stressed the need for DBE participation and effort to secure DBE participation.

Clarification:

- Item 1. Scope of Work dated May 10, 2022, Line #5, omit the word " thirty-two (32)" and replace with **Sixteen (16)**. Line # 5 shall now read as follows:

Provide and install a sixteen (16) channel NVR with a minimum thirty (30) day recording capacity.

Forms and Specifications:

- Item 1. Revised Bid Form (attached to the document) to include cost of providing and installing an additional outdoor camera.

Requests for Information:

- Question 1. Do you want two (2) Axis S1116 NVRs with 16 camera licenses each? Or do you want one (1) Axis S1116 NVR with 16 camera licenses but that has the capability to expand up to 32 cameras in future by purchasing additional licenses?
ONE AXIS S1116 NVR WITH 16 CAMERA LICENSES THAT HAS THE CAPABILITY TO EXPAND UP TO 32 CAMERAS.
- Question 2. Is the City providing a POE network switch for the Project?
YES. POE SWITCH AND POWER SUPPLIES WILL BE PROVIDED BY CITY.
- Question 3. Would you consider another type of VMS besides Axis?
YES, HOWEVER ALL SUBSTITUTIONS MUST BE NDAA SECTION 809 COMPLIANT.
- Questions 4. Must the hardware that VMS software runs be manufactured by the same company?
WE ARE NOT REQUIRING AN INSTALLATION THAT HAS VMS SOFTWARE RUNNING REMOTELY.
- Question 5. Can the NVR be an embedded type NVR which runs embedded software on the NVR hardware?
YES
- Question 6. The bid specifies two monitors to be wall mounted but only asks for one Tripp Lite Display wall mount. Will one monitor be wall mounted and one monitor be on a desk?
THERE WILL BE TWO (2) WALL-MOUNTED MONITORS AND ONE (1) DESKTOP LOCATION.
- Question 7. What distance from the NVR will the monitors be located? Will both monitors display the same screen?
NVR WILL BE LOCATED OFFICE DURING PRE-BID. A PRIMARY AND SECONDARY LINES WILL BE RUN TO 2ND FLOOR NETWORK CLOSET.
Will the City provide a battery backup UPS System for the cameras head-end equipment or should a battery backup UPS be included in the bid?
A BATTERY BACKUP UPS SYSTEM IS TO BE INCLUDED IN THE BID.

5. Special Instructions or conditions.
 - a. RESTROOM FACILITIES: Contractor may utilize restroom facilities at the building.
 - b. UTILITIES: Contractor may utilize, without cost, the water and electrical service of the facility in moderate amounts.
 - c. PARKING: There is no reserved parking. Contractor must utilize on-street parking.
 - d. ACCESS/ HOURS of OPERATION: When the building is in use by its occupants, typical open hours of operation are as follows:
Monday through Friday 8am – 5pm
 - e. WASTE REMOVAL: The Contractor shall be responsible for leaving the work area and adjacent site clear of equipment and debris, etc at the end of each work day. Maintain the site in a clean and orderly condition. Dispose of construction debris legal off site.
