A	ddress is visible from the street.
Fi	ire drills are documented.
Fi	ire safety and evacuation plans are in compliance.
E	xit doors open with little effort and have proper hardware.
E	xits are clear of obstructions.
E	mergency lighting is operational.
Fi	ire alarm is in compliance and has a current inspection.
S	prinkler is in compliance and has a current inspection.
2	A/10 BC extinguisher is in compliance and has a current inspection.
H	ood suppression is installed over cooking appliances.
H	ood suppression is in compliance and has a current inspection.
C	lass K fire extinguisher is in compliance and has a current inspection
L	ess than 20% of walls covered in decorative materials.
H	leat source(s) are properly protected.
P	roper use of electrical equipment and multi plug adaptors.
O	outlet covers are on unused receptacles.
C	ombustible Storage is stacked 2' below the ceiling height.

This office is concerned with identifying conditions that promote a safe environment free of fire hazards including but not limited to the above key concepts from the 2021 International Fire Code and DHR. This document is meant for guidance in preparation of a requested Fire Code Inspection, it is not meant to limit the Fire Code Officials Inspection.
