

How to Dispose of Your Old Fire Extinguisher

Contact a local Fire Safety Equipment Dealer and determine if your fire extinguisher can simply be re-charged.

If the extinguisher can be re-charged, make arrangements with the dealer to have your extinguisher serviced for continued use.

If your extinguisher cannot be re-charged then ask if the dealer accepts extinguishers for disposal. If they do make arrangements for dropping off the extinguisher for proper disposal.

Question & Answers

1. How do I locate a fire safety equipment dealer?

Simply perform an internet search for “fire extinguisher contractors Mobile, AL” and a number of local business contacts will populate on your browser.

Be sure to ask if the contractor accepts fire extinguishers prior to physically visiting their location, saving yourself time and money.

2. Is there a fee for disposing of fire extinguishers?

There should be no charge associated with the disposal of fire extinguishers.

The City of Mobile does not recommend disposing of fire extinguishers with household trash due to life safety risk. These canisters are pressurized.
