MPRD is honored to introduce our featured Programmatic Partner organization, **The GLOVe Foundation**, and its founder and **President Ronald Davis**.

Established in 2009 to offer youth in Mobile access to local golf programming without having to travel, this training and mentoring program has been providing services at the Azalea City Golf Course for the past six years.

#### Golf programs through the GLOVe Foundation include:

- **LGPA Girls Golf** – An LGPA and USGA certified program for girls ages 7 – 17.
- **GLOVe-4-Boyz** – A youth boys program developed in cooperation with the Boy Scouts of South Alabama in support of their Merit Badge Series.
- **Sticks for Kids** – A junior golf outreach program for youth ages 5-18 that supports underprivileged children by providing each Sticks for Kids location with clubs, bags, teaching and marketing materials, and instructions for participating courses.
- **First Tee: Gulf Coast** – A co-ed program for youth ages 7-17 that uses the game of golf to teach unique life skills curriculum.

All programs are overseen by Mr. Davis, who also hosts the Diversified Women of Mobile Golfers every second Sunday of the month and now offers Saturday afternoon sessions for children with disabilities.
