The City of Mobile was awarded a \$14.5 million TIGER FY 2016 grant for One Mobile: Reconnecting People, Work and Play through Complete Streets Initiative. As part of this initiative, we propose to completely reconstruct Broad and Beauregard streets and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Avenue to repair aging infrastructure, add bike and pedestrian connections, and create Complete Streets to better serve our community. We need dramatic change; our six goals are multi-faceted:






- Provide safe pedestrian- and bicycle-friendly access for residents, workers, and visitors;
- Reconnect separated neighborhoods currently divided by Broad Street’s seven-lane expanse;
- Accommodate all modes of travel with efficient connections between neighborhoods, transportation hubs, major employment centers, and local destinations;
- Reconstruct aging infrastructure;
- Create attractive, welcoming, and cohesive streetscapes; and
- Stimulate an economically vibrant and active street environment.

Realization of One Mobile: Reconnecting People, Work and Play through Complete Streets will transform Mobile by creating:

- Inviting gateways and street design to draw people to the heart of our community;
- A cohesive street network with strong links to all neighborhoods, including geographically or demographically disparate areas;
- A high-functioning transportation hub offering residents and visitors attractive, safe, and efficient routes of travel with inviting options for non-motorized travel; and,
- Increased opportunities for recreation as well as improved health and wellness through enhanced connections, sidewalks, greenways, trails, and bike lanes.
