Congress Street Closed at N. Broad Street

Mobile, AL – Both lanes of Congress Street will be closed at Broad/Beauregard Street from Monday, January 6th, and will reopen Monday, February 3rd. The closure will enable workers to relocate utility lines and complete drainage work.

Local and through traffic will be redirected as follows:

- To Westbound Congress St. redirected from N. Broad St. to westbound Lyons St. to Kennedy St. to Congress St.
- To Eastbound Congress St. redirected from N. Broad St. to eastbound Lyons St. to N. Washington St. to Congress St.

All activities are weather-dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers are reminded to obey the 25-mph speed limit and to use caution when traveling through the work zone, especially at night. Motorists should watch for construction workers and equipment entering and exiting the roadway.
