Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Avenue Closed at Broad Street

Mobile, AL – The closure of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Ave. at Broad St. in the City of Mobile will be **extended** to Monday, January 6th. This extension is due to the discovery of a utility conflict.

Local and through traffic will continue to be redirected as follows:

- North of Broad/Beauregard St. will be redirected to Lawrence St. to Short Bloodgood/Earl St. to Marmotte St.
- South of Broad/Beauregard St. will be directed to Lawrence and Congress streets.

All activities are weather-dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers are reminded to obey the 25-mph speed limit and to use caution, especially at night, when traveling through the work zone. Motorists should also watch for construction workers and equipment entering and exiting the roadway.
