Temporary Closure of Congress Street at N. Broad Street

MOBILE, Ala. – A section of Congress Street on the east side of the North Broad Street intersection will be closed Monday, Nov. 9 from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. to prepare the area for paving.

The existing Springhill Avenue detour will remain in place, and the following streets will also be utilized for a detour around the work at the intersection of Broad and Congress Streets.

- North Washington Street
- Lyons Street
- Dauphin Street

All local businesses are open and have signs directing drivers to alternate entrances.

All activities are weather-dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers should obey the 25-mph speed limit and use caution when traveling through the work zone, especially at night. Drivers are also asked to keep an eye out for construction workers and equipment entering and exiting the roadway.
