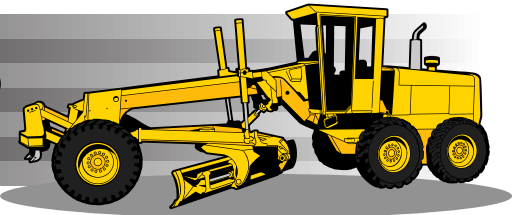

Did you know?

- Graders can produce inclined surfaces, such as giving a gentle slope to roads. The slope is a very important safety factor as it directs water to run off of the surface and into the drainage system.
- On straight sections of normal two-lane roads, the pavement cross section is usually highest in the center and drains to both sides.
