N. Broad Street Closure from St. Louis Street to Congress Street Intersection Postponed

Mobile, AL – The temporary closure of N. Broad Street from St. Louis Street through the Congress Street intersection has been postponed due to impending weather. The new anticipated dates for the closure are Monday, June 15, through Sunday, June 28. During the closure, crews will install a new water main, sanitary sewer, and storm drainage in the area.

N. Broad Street traffic will be detoured to N. Washington Avenue using St. Louis Street and Lyons Street. Signs and variable message boards will be in place to alert drivers of the closure and alternate routes.

The following streets will be utilized for the detour:

- St. Louis Street
- N Washington Avenue
- Lyons Street

All activities are weather-dependent and may be delayed or rescheduled in the event of inclement weather. Drivers are reminded to obey the 25-mph speed limit and to use caution when traveling through the work zone, especially at night. Motorists should watch for construction workers and equipment entering and exiting the roadway.
