The defendant having applied for the benefits of probation and the Court having examined the cause, it is ORDERED, ADJUDED, and DECREED that the said sentence is hereby suspended and that the said defendant is probationed on this date for a period of _____.

It is the order of the Court that the probationer comply with the following general and special conditions of probation: **That the Probationer is hereby ordered and referred to assessment, evaluation, and treatment if required by the Court Appointed Probation Officer and shall pay all fines, court costs, restitution and assessment and monitoring fees, and education and /or treatment program fees, unless ruled by the court to be indigent.**

Do not be arrested for violating any Federal, State, or local law.

Avoid injurious or vicious habits.

From this day forward, the Probationer shall not consume alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs during the pendency of his/her probation.

Avoid persons or places of disreputable or harmful character.

Report to the Court Appointed Probation Officer as directed.

Submit to substance abuse testing when ordered to do so by the Court Appointed Probation Officer. These tests shall also include urinalysis, breathalyzer, and blood or hair samples, but not limited thereto. Probationer will pay costs of tests.

Permit the Court Appointed Probation Officer to visit him/her at his/her home or elsewhere, and to submit to search by the Court Appointed Probation Officer of his person, residence, vehicle, or any property under his control.

That the Probationer commit no other offenses including traffic offenses, drug, and alcohol related offenses or offenses against the person or property of another during the period of probation.

That the Probationer take no action of any kind to harm, threaten or harass any witness who might have testified against him/her or furnished evidence leading to his/her arrest.

Probationer is not to have contact with the victim.

Probationer must maintain a valid mailing address with the Court Appointed Probation Officer at all times during the period of probation.

Probationer should adhere to all court dates provided by the Court Appointed Probation Officer.

Other special conditions ordered by the Court are as follows:

It is further ordered of the Court and the defendant is hereby advised that the Court may at any time revoke or modify any conditions of this probation or change the period of probation and may discharge defendant from probation or extend the period of probation. The probationer shall be subject to arrest for violation of any condition of the probation herein granted. The Court may, at any time, for cause, order the original sentence executed.
