6 WHEREAS, with great pride and special pleasure,
7 highest commendations are conveyed to Mayor Sandy Stimpson
8 for his faithful and unwavering service to the citizens of
9 Mobile and its surrounding areas; and

10 WHEREAS, the City of Mobile's 108th Mayor, William
11 Sandy Stimpson, cast a bold mission for Mobile's citizens to
12 become One Mobile – a safer, more business-friendly and
13 family-friendly city – drawing on decades of experience in
14 private business and civic leadership; and

15 WHEREAS, Mayor Stimpson has proven that the greatest
16 level of success is achieved when everyone has a seat at the
17 table and collaboration is at the heart of government; and

18 WHEREAS, Mayor Stimpson's tenure has been marked by a
19 commitment to transparency, effectiveness, and efficiency,
20 as well as accomplishments that will have lasting positive
21 impacts in Mobile and beyond, including an unparalleled
22 reform of city finances; Mr. Stimpson reduced bonded
23 indebtedness by nearly \$210 million, drastically improved

31 initiatives, including an overhaul of Mobile's outdated
32 zoning code, the creation of a nationally recognized program
33 to reduce urban blight, a successful annexation effort that
34 made Mobile the second-largest city in Alabama, a
35 significant drop in major crimes across the city, and
36 unprecedented growth in economic development and new jobs
37 that will have a lasting impact on generations of Mobilians;

39 WHEREAS, under Mr. Stimpson's leadership, several
40 long-awaited projects have taken major steps forward,
41 including the new, state-of-the-art entertainment arena
42 currently under construction downtown; major investments in
43 Mobile's waterfront; the purchase of the Brookley by the Bay
44 property; the construction of a passenger air terminal in
45 downtown Mobile; and millions of dollars of investments in
46 parks, public facilities, and shared spaces across the City
47 of Mobile; and
