The Vice-Chairman, Captain Roy Hodge, called the meeting to order at 9:06 a.m.

The Vice-Chairman presented the **minutes of the regular Board meeting of July 23, 2016.** Captain Lee moved for approval, with a second from Mr. Singleton, the minutes were approved as written and distributed.

The Vice-Chairman presented the Personnel Action Notice of DROP retirement effective September 1, 2016 submitted by **Police Corporal Billie J. Dunn, Mobile Police Department.** As of August 31, 2016 Corporal Dunn will be 59 years old and will have served 20.06 years. He has elected the maximum option with no benefits payable to a survivor. *Captain Lee moved for approval, with a second by Mr. Singleton, the motion carried.*

The Vice-Chairman presented the Personnel Action Notice of DROP retirement effective September 1, 2016 submitted by **Fire Service Captain Walter G. Riley, III, Mobile Fire Department.** As of August 31, 2016 Captain Riley will be 50 years old and will have served 27.52 years. He has elected the 100% joint and survivor annuity option with the 'pop-up' feature. *Captain Lee moved for approval, with a second by District Chief Lami, the motion carried.*

The Vice-Chairman presented the Personnel Action Notice of **Police Corporal Lester Hargrove, III,** of his intent to leave the Police Department and withdraw from the DROP to enter active retirement effective August 31, 2016. *Captain Jackson moved for approval, with a second by Mr. Singleton, the motion carried.*

The Vice-Chairman presented the Personnel Action Notice of retirement effective August 11, 2016 submitted by **Fire Service Captain Charles A. Curreri, Mobile Fire Department.** As of August 10, 2016 Captain Curreri will be 54 years old and will have served 27.33 years. He has elected the 100% joint and survivor annuity option with the 'pop-up' feature. *Captain Lee moved for approval, with a second by District Chief Lami, the motion carried.*

The Vice-Chairman presented the Personnel Action Notice submitted by **Fire Service Driver Ronald W. Broughton, Mobile Fire Department**, of his intent to retire effective August 10, 2016 with benefits deferred to February 2, 2024 at which time he will be 55 years of age. *Captain Lee moved for approval*, with a second by District Chief Lami, the motion carried.
