The Chairman, Mr. Terry Lilley, called the meeting to order at 9:53 a.m.

The Chairman presented the minutes of the regular Board meeting of October 28, 2015. Captain Lee moved for approval, with a second from Captain Hodge, the minutes were approved as written and distributed.

The Chairman presented a Personnel Action Notice of DROP retirement effective December 1, 2015 submitted by **Police Major Kara L. Rose, Mobile Police Department.** As of November 30, 2015 Major Rose will be 51 years old and will have served 26.51 years. She has elected the 100% joint and survivor annuity option with the 'pop-up' feature. *Captain Hodge moved for approval, with a second by Captain Lee, the motion carried.*

The Chairman presented the Personnel Action Notice of retirement effective November 14, 2015 submitted by **Police Sergeant Ignatius E. Thomas, Mobile Police Department**. As of November 13, 2015 Sergeant Thomas will be 59 years old and will have served 24.62 years. He has elected the 50% joint and survivor annuity option without the 'pop-up' feature. *Captain Hodge moved for approval, it was seconded by Captain Lee, and the motion carried.*

The Chairman presented the Personnel Action Notice submitted by **Fire Service Captain Eric D. Creel, Mobile Fire Department**, of his intent to retire effective November 19, 2015 with benefits deferred to July 29, 2039 at which time he will be 65 years of age. *Captain Connick moved for approval, with a second by Captain Lee, the motion carried.*
